
Subject: REGISTRATION OF "AGRO AND NON AGRO PRODUCTS" AS GEOGRAPHICAL INDICATIONS BY PAKISTAN

Geographical Indications (GIs) are a form of Intellectual Property Rights (IPRS). They identify a product originating from a specific area whose quality or reputation is attributable to its place of origin. In Pakistan, Geographical Indications (Registration and Protection) Act, 2020 (GI Act, 2020) has been enacted in March 2020 to provide for registration and effective protection of the products bearing GI originating from Pakistan.

Government of Pakistan has initiated registration of products bearing 2. Geographical Indication from Pakistan, in this connection, Basmati has been registered as a January 21, 2021 whereas process for protecting Pink Rock Salt commenced on February 22, 2021, A significant number of other products from Pakistan also have potential to be protected under the GI Act, 2020. GI's of Pakistan will serve as a potential economic tool to promote and enhance national and international trade attracting global demand and premium price for Pakistan. Ministry of Commerce has initiated a process of identifying public bodies to be authorized as Registrants by Federal Government by virtue of section Cheu 11 (2) of the GI Act, 2020 so that the registration process for GIs can be initiated by the respective stakeholders/agencies.

The role of a Registrant in the registration process for GI's is important as the responsibility to formulate the Book of Specifications lies with the Registrants as per the GI Act, 2020. This Book of Specifications is an essential document that contains the name, description of the product bearing geographical indication, principal characteristics, methods to obtain the product, definition of cographical area (mapping), link between quality product and geographical environment and evidence that the product originated from the defined geographical area etc.
